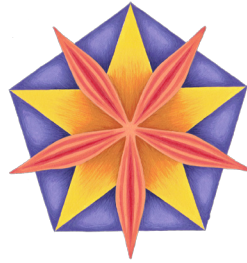

## **Karmic Relationships in Light of the Christmas Conference**

It is extraordinarily important to read Karmic Relationships in the right sequence. Unfortunately, neither the German nor the English edition offers the texts in the right chronological order. Reading the first several lectures in the order in which they were given reveals a startling pattern: after the Christmas Conference, which renewed all of anthroposophy, Steiner begins his Karma lectures with a recapitulation of his earlier work.

## **Social Justice in the Light of Reincarnation and Karma**

The second lecture compares Steiner's insights into social justice in light of reincarnation and karma with the two best philosophers writing on justice in the world: John Rawls and Peter Singer. The former's work will be shown to be far less compelling than Steiner's, while the latter's can inspire us to make a thought experiment that is a perfect example of moral imagination, whereby we can imagine the moral universe as sufficiently large that reincarnation and karma come into play.

## **About Frederick Amrine**

Professor Amrine teaches literature, philosophy and intellectual history at the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, where he is Arthur F. Thurnau professor in German Studies. He has been a student of anthroposophy his entire adult life.
